This side contains no complete sentences about the characters or the setting.
Left Side(x2)	This side includes a well-written summary of the problem & solution of the book. The student identifies details about the problem & the solution that "grab" the readers' attention.	This side has a summary of the problem & solution of the book. It does not "grab" the readers' attention because it is missing some important details about the problem & solution.	The summary of the problem & solution of the book has missing information. It is poorly written with several mistakes.	There is no summary of the problem & solution of the book.
Back(x2)	Designs a game that is based upon the story. It is neat, creative, & includes information from the book.	Designs a game that is somewhat based on the book. It is somewhat neat, creative, & includes information from the book.	Designs a game that is not related to the story. It includes little information from the book. It lacks creativity and neatness.	Game is unrelated to the book. OR There is no game present.
Top	Includes the title, author, number of pages in your book, & the number of stars you gave your book.	The top is missing one of the elements: title, author, number of pages, or number of stars.	The top is missing two or three of the following element: title, author, number of pages, or number of stars.	The top does not contain any of the required elements.
Prize	The prize is relevant to the book: a symbol of the story, something the main character could have used in the book, or something that reminds the student of their character.	The prize is something the main character could have used. The meaning behind it is a little unclear.	A prize is available, but does not relate to the main character.	There is not a prize included.
