Your assignment is the following:

- Information Page including the following information. Remember, information must be presented in your own words! (1 – 2 pages).
 - * Identify what a constellation is (definition)
 - * Identify where the constellation can be observed in the night sky
 - * Identify when the constellation can be observed in the night sky
 - * List the stars that make up your constellation
 - * Explain how the constellation got its name
 - * Summarize the myth behind the constellation
- 2. A "star-map": Using black construction paper provided... create an image of your constellation. Be sure to put:
- * A title (the name of your constellation) and your name on the back of the paper.
- * The star spots and outline of the constellation.
- * Label any of the named stars in your constellation
